Parents please remember that drop off time is between 8 am and 8:30 am. If you are going to be later than 8:30 am please call the Head Start or Early Head Start at 374-0066 ext.216 so the teachers know to expect your child for breakfast. Head Start has a required 85% attendance policy, which is typically an absence of a day or two a month.

Please remember to send your child with a warm jacket, gloves, and hat. We want all our little ones to stay cozy and warm during outdoor

Your Child's Health

1. **Keep up with your child's physical.** Remember to schedule your child's yearly physical. 2. **Protect their smile.** Encourage your child to brush their teeth twice a day and see your dentist twice a year for a cleaning. 3. **Use sunscreen.** It is recommended that sunscreen is used every morning. 4. **Be safety minded.** Never leave a child under 5 in the tub alone. Make sure car seats are installed correctly, and insist that your child wear a helmet when riding their bike or scooter.

Used Oil Facts

- ♦ It is against the law to use new or used motor oil as a weed killer or dust controller.
- ♦ It is illegal to burn used oil, bury used oil, dump into a trash can, storm drain or sewer.
- ♦ Used oil is considered a hazardous waste in California.
- ♦ For every 1 gallon of used oil recovered, 2.5 quarts of re-fined oil can be produced

Based on Cal Recycle data, California recycles approximately 100 million gallons of used oil annually. Recycling Infrastructure in Fresno County, retailers are Auto Zone, Home Depot, Ace Hardware and Napa in Auberry / Prather Area.

Spring Composting

Spring is the ideal time to launch a compost pile, using nutrient-rich kitchen scraps and yard waste to fuel your garden. Balance 1 part green materials (grass Clippings, veggie scraps) with 3 parts brown materials (dried leaves, twigs, shredded paper). Turn the pile weekly to speed decomposition, keep it moist like a wrung-out sponge, and start new piles to let older ones mature. Size matters, you need to chop up larger yard waste, such as pruned branches, into smaller pieces to speed up your decomposition. What to avoid in your compost pile. Do not add meat, fish dairy, or oils to avoid pests. You can revive your pile after winter, turn your compost pile to aerate it and introduce oxygen which kickstarts decomposition.

2026 MISSING MURDERED INDIGENOUS PEOPLE TRIBAL POLICY SUMMIT

In February, the Big Sandy Rancheria Social Services Team and Tribal Council Secretary Mathew Munoz represented Big Sandy Rancheria at the 4th Annual MMIP Tribal Policy Summit, hosted by the Yurok Tribe at Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Sacramento at Fire Mountain in Wheatland.

Nearly 1,000 Tribal leaders, lawmakers, families, advocates, and legal experts gathered to strengthen partnerships and advance solutions to the MMIP crisis. Big Sandy Rancheria was proud to stand with Tribal Nations in reaffirming our commitment to the safety and well-being of our community.



MMIP FRESNO COUNTY COALITION PANEL

The MMIP Fresno County Coalition meets weekly and is organized by Indigenous Justice as a community-led effort. The coalition includes local tribes, community partners, members, and impacted families working together to address the crisis of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People (MMIP).



During the summit, the coalition highlighted its coordinated response efforts and community-driven solutions in the Fresno area, many of which were shaped by the case of Bessie Walker. Rayetta Lara, Bessie's sister, shared her family's story and spoke about her ongoing commitment to seeking justice and creating lasting change.

IMPACTED FAMILIES PANEL

At the MMIP Summit, Indigenous Justice hosted a panel with impacted families who shared memories of their loved ones and the challenges they face in seeking justice. Rayetta Lara of Big Sandy Rancheria, sister of Bessie Walker, was among the panelists, honoring her sister with strength and love.
