If caught, you can find yourself with a hefty fine of more than \$5,000.00 or imprisonment for more than six months, or both.

Finally, the Big Sandy Rancheria Family Service Center is now complete. The crew are putting in the final touches to the outside playground area. Once fully operational, the tribe will be having a grand opening ceremony for all to enjoy. Please be on the lookout for more information on the date and time.

To the tribal members living on the Rancheria, please conserve water. This water shortage issue has to do with some illegal actives happening on the Rancheria near Comstock area. If anyone is caught tampering with our Community Water System. Tribal Council will have no other option but to bring justice to those individuals. Major Causes of Groundwater Contamination

Groundwater contamination is defined as the addition of undesirable substances to groundwater caused by human activities. This can be caused by chemicals, road salt, bacteria, viruses, medications, fertilizers, and fuel.

Underground water can get contaminated from industrial, domestic, and agricultural chemicals from the surface. This includes chemicals such as pesticides and herbicides that many homeowners apply to their lawns. Contaminations of groundwater by Road salt is a major concern in northern areas of the United States.

Sanitary Landfill

Fresno Sanitary Landfill is the oldest "true" sanitary landfill in the United States, and the oldest compartmentalized municipal landfill in the western United States. It is the first landfill to empty the trench method of disposal and first to utilize compaction. This method was layering of refuse and dirt in trenches, compacting the dirt and covering the filled area daily to minimize rodent and debris problems. Today Sanitary landfills are sites where waste is isolated from the environment until it is safe. Methane, a toxic gas, is produced from decomposition it is collected in the landfill to generate electricity instead of being released into the atmosphere.



YOUR APPOINTMENT MUST BE MADE AND VERIFIED WITH THE CAP DEPARTMENT *BEFORE* YOUR SPOT CAN BE RESERVED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. SCHEDULE APPOINTMENTS ONLY WITH SAIGE RILEY 24 HOURS PRIOR FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTS AND 1 WEEK IN ADVANCE FOR FRESNO TRANSPORTS.

The transporter will wait 15 minutes after your scheduled departure. If you do not arrive on time, your appointment will be canceled and can be rescheduled <u>with Saige</u> <u>Riley only</u>. There are new rules for the transportation services, please call the transporter for a copy of revised rules. Transportation services are for Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Members. The transporter cannot transport kids to school that have missed the bus. All CVIH appointments are to be scheduled with CVIH transporter. If the CVIH transporter is unable to transport you, they will need to reschedule your appointment. This applies to all medical, dental, nutrition & referral appointments. *ATTENTION ALL TRANSPORTATION PARTICIPANTS*
