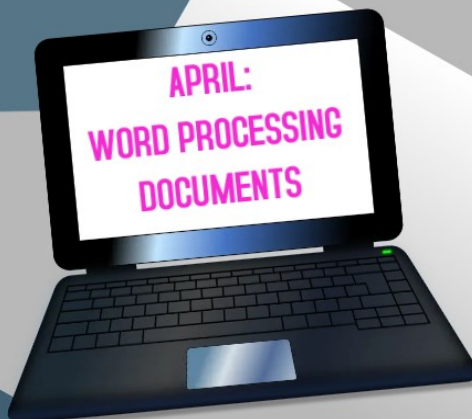

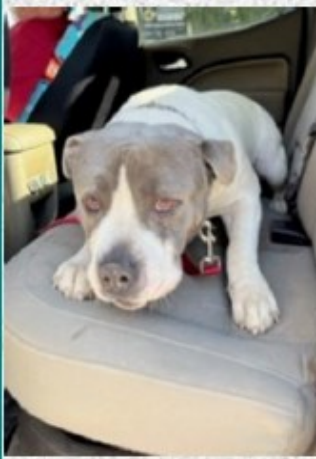

## **Adapting to climate Hazards**

The way communities adapts to climate change will depend on how climate change is affecting the region where that community is located . Climate change is not the same everywhere. For example in some areas it causing floods to become more frequent. In other areas it might be a heat wave that are more hazardous in your area. Indigenous and local communities live in close contact with their environment: they know it intimately, they depend on it, and are directly affected by it's degradation. It effects not only our traditional supplies for basket making it also effects our natural medicine that we use. Therefore, efforts to maintain, restore and manage a healthy environment are more likely to succeed if they intergrade the traditional knowledge of these communities.

## Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Head Start Program

Our students had a very busy March! All our students drew a poster for the Smokey bear fire safety contest. They are looking forward to his visit in April.

Our annual Easter egg hunt was held on March 31st during outdoor time. We all had a great time!

Parents with Head Start children moving on to Foothill next year: We will have information and TK/Kindergarten registration packets. Please be on the look out for flyers.

Parents please remember that drop off time is between 8 am and 8:30 am. If you are going to be later than 8:30 am please call the Head Start at 374-0066 ext.216 so the teachers know to expect your child for breakfast.

Head Start has a required 85% attendance policy, which is typically an absence of a day or two a month.

### Your Child's Health

1. **Keep up with your child's physical.** Remember to schedule your child's yearly physical. 2. **Protect their smile.** Encourage your child to brush their teeth twice a day and see your dentist once a year for a cleaning. 3. **Use sunscreen.** It is recommended that sunscreen is used every morning. 4. **Be safety minded.** Never leave a child under 5 in the tub alone. Make sure car seats are installed correctly, and insist that your child wear a helmet when riding their bike or scooter.

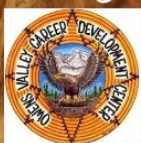



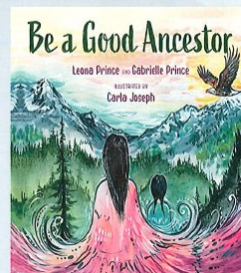
