The Tribal Council would like to wish everyone a Happy Valentines Day and would like to announce that Big Sandy Rancheria has had The Tribal Gaming Compact signed by the Governor, Gavin Newsome. Tribal Council has recently met with Jim Patterson, 8th Assembly District member and he has agreed to authorize the bill. Next month we will provide an update on where the bill is in the legislative process. As an addition to this , The Gaming Commission has a new member on board in which we would like to welcome, Mr. Ramon Ramirez to the team. The Council has been collaborating with the SUSD to implement a new native curriculum. Focused on the local native history of the surrounding areas which will be implemented into the K-12 curriculum for the upcoming 2024/2025 school years. Tribal Council has officially moved and now are located in the old TANF building, all of the extensions and emails have remained the same. Tribal Council would like to remind all residents here on the rancheria about the pet policy. There are supposed to only be two dogs per household. There has been a surplus of unclaimed dogs and is creating issues. Please be courteous to all the tribal members and residents here on the rancheria and honor this simple rule. ## What is illegal Dumping?



It is the act of disposing of solid waste at a location that is not a permitted solid waste disposal facility. Illegal dumping is dumping of any waste, whether it is oil, furniture appliances, trash, litter or landscaping cuttings, tires Etc. California's local government spend tens of millions of dollars to remove and clean up illegal dumping. State and local agencies will cite people caught illegally dumping.

## How to Recycle Household Goods

**Aerosol Cans**— Pull off the plastic cap and empty the canister completely.

**Batteries** — household batteries can be taken to Office Depot. Car batteries can be taken to retailer.

**Cell Phones** — Many cell phone companies and office supply stores offer phone recycling service.

**DVDs, CDs** — CD Recycling Center Of America

**Wire hangers** — Can be recycled with your metal, just take off any attached paper or cardboard.

**iPods, iPhones, and other Apple devices** — can be traded in for store credit to put toward a new Apple product.

**Plastic bottle caps** — You do not need to remove the plastic caps. Recycle your bottles with the caps.

**Plastic shopping bags** — You can drop off at your local grocery store. To be reused.

**Tinfoil** — can be recycled with your aluminum cans.

# BSR Head Start

## Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Head Start Program

Parents please remember that drop off is between 8 am and 8:30 am. If you are going to be later than 8:30 am please call the Head Start, so the teachers know to expect your child for breakfast. Head Start has a required 85% attendance policy, which is typically an absence of a day or two a month. But with the cold season we understand that sometimes students need a few recovery days and ask that you gives us a call to check in.

Healthy kids make happy kids!

### Germ Proof Your Child:

Here at the center we see the common cold, stomach flu, ear infections, and on rare occasions the flu. Here are a few tips to keep your family healthy during the cold season. And just a reminder it is not too late to get your flu shots. 1) Hand Washing: hands should be washed for 20 seconds. This should be done before meals, after bathroom breaks, and if your child touches other kids, toys, and pets. 2) Keep wipes & sanitizing gel while on the go. 3) Sneeze and cough into a tissue. Or use the crook of your elbow 4) Do not let your child share drinks, utensils, or personal items with anybody. Including caregivers and siblings.
