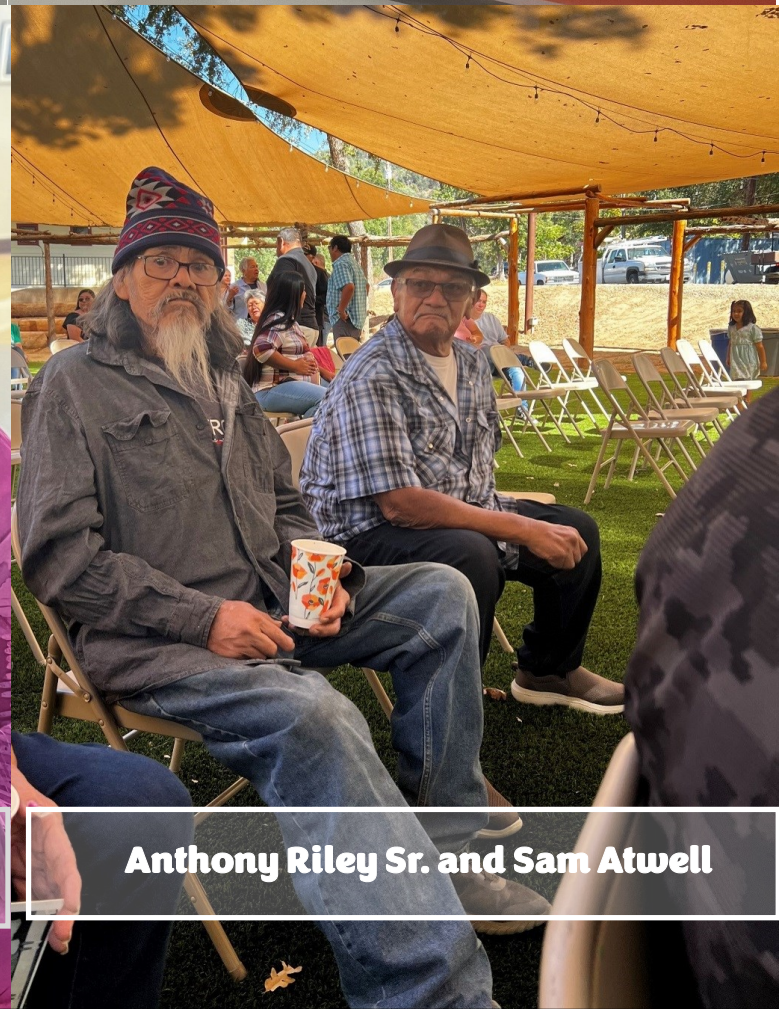

Solid-Waste Management

Solid-waste management, is collecting, treating, and disposing of solid material that is discarded because it has served its purpose or is no longer useful. Improper disposal of solid waste can create unsanitary conditions, and these conditions in turn can lead to pollution of the environment and outbreaks of vector-borne disease that is, diseases spread by rodents and insect. Open and unsanitary landfills contribute to contamination of our drinking water and can cause infection and transmit diseases. The tasks of solid-waste management present complex technical challenges. That has to be delt with on a day to day bases.

Thank you to all of the BSR residents that participated in our community clean up week. As a reminder please do not dump appliances and other larger trash items if the dumpster has already reached capacity. We have only one staff that manages our community solid waste and Ponderosa will not accept the dumpster if it looks like this. We offer this event free to BSR residences with grant funding and appreciate the consideration for the time and effort it takes our department.



This is Tire recycling month

If you have old tires that you need to get rid of them, you can drop them off at the Transfer station, if you don't have a vehicle you can leave them next to your weekly trash. They will be pick up. If your dropping off your tires at the transfer station do not put them in the roll off bin, stack them neatly next to the fence.

America Recycle Day

This year is the 22nd anniversary of America Recycles Day (ARD). On this day, Americans celebrated by renewing their pledge to recycle. On November 19, 1994, two employees of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, Kevin Tuerff and Valerie Davis, suggested the idea to the National Recycling Coalition's Congress (NRC) and it was immediately embraced. At least 40 states participated in the first America Recycles Day.
