Big Sandy Transfer Station is only accepting bagged household trash. DO NOT leave or throw large items in the trash bins. DO NOT leave items outside the transfer station. The Environmental Department provides community clean up events for larger trash items. Please look for clean up dates in the environmental newsletter.

What is Soil Erosion

Soil erosion is the wearing away of top soil by water, wind, ice, or snow. Human activity can significantly increase erosion rate. It's a natural process that affects all landforms. It also impacts our water quality. The sediments from the erosion can be transported into our water. With the wet weather upon us, here at Big Sandy you can prevent soil erosion by using mulch, plant ground cover, use wood chips, place crushed rock.

Big Sandy and Climate Change

Timing of natural events, such as blooming flowers and animal migration, can be influenced by changes in climate. Phenology events are influenced by a combination of environmental factors, including temperature, light, rainfall, and humidity. Different plant and animal species respond to different phenological. Disruptions in the timing of these events can have a variety of impacts on ecosystems and human society. Early spring may cause longer allergy seasons. Unusually warm weather can cause a "false Spring" which cause plants to bloom to early. If you look around Big Sandy you can already see the changes in the phenology events. With warmer weather and sporadic rain.

A roll off will be available at the transfer station the week of April 21st to April 25th. All items need to be put inside of the roll off bin. Do not leave items next to roll off. Items that cannot be dumped; motor oil, flammable liquids, and tires. Open to BSR community ONLY.

Family Spirit Home Visiting Program

BSR's Social Services, Stephanie Casillas and Jazmine Garcia recently completed the Family Spirit Health Educator program. The Family Spirit Program covers a wide range of maternal and child health topics, using strengths-based, culturally focused content. Family Spirit is also the first program to provide clear evidence of the effectiveness of paraprofessionals as home visitors to impact behavioral and mental health disparities. The use of paraprofessionals is essential in communities where there is a shortage of nurses and cultural barriers.

Family Spirit produces positive outcomes in parenting, maternal outcomes, and child outcomes including:

Increased maternal knowledge
Increased parent self-efficacy
Reduced parent stress
Improved home safety attitudes
Decreased maternal depression
Decreased substance use

Fewer behavior problems in children through age 3 (externalizing, internalizing, and dysregulation)

Predicts lower risk of substance use and behavioral health problems over the life course.

The program is designed to be taught one-on-one during home visits, but can also be used in group settings, depending on the family needs.

Big Sandy is partnering with the Fresno American Indian Health Project (FAIHP) on this project.
