#### Air Quality

Did you know that air pollution is actually worse during winter months. Cold air moves slower than warm air. Cold air density traps in air pollution. Air pollution in the winter remains in place for much longer and their fore we breath it in at a much faster rate than in the summer when it is warmer. Having house plants is a good way to purify the air in your home. Not only that it is a way to produce more oxygen circulating around your home. Having house plants can reduce levels of carbon monoxide, formaldehyde, xylene, and benzene. Plus it is a good way to decorate your home.

#### Indigenous Plants & Native Uses

- MILKWEED—Treat bowel and Kidney disorders.
- ELDERBERRY— Bark is used as a pain killer. Crushed leaves insect repellant.
- CATTAIL—Can be placed directly on cuts to control bleeding.
- GROUND PINE—Used for stiff joints.
- WINTERGREEN—Tea from the leaves ease rheumatism. The oil can be used for aspirin.
- WILD STRAWBERRY—The leaves may stimulate appetite.

#### What is groundwater and why is it so important

Thinking about freshwater often brings to mind pictures of flowing steams and crystal clear lakes, but actually, almost all freshwater is ground water. Groundwater is water found underground in cracks and spaces in soil, sand, and rock. It is held in aquiferspermeable water-bearing rock and or sediment and can be extracted through wells or bubbles up naturally through a spring or discharged int lake or streams. Even though the water is underground, when it does bubble up or flow into streams, groundwater helps to replenish and maintain levels of surface water-these are bodies of water that we see as river, lakes, streams. Ground water helps keep our river flowing.




#### **BSR CAP DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY TORTILLA CHALLENGE**

YOUR APPOINTMENT MUST BE MADE AND VERIFIED WITH THE CAP DEPARTMENT BEFORE YOUR SPOT CAN BE RESERVED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. SCHEDULE APPOINTMENTS ONLY WITH SAIGE RILEY 24 HOURS PRIOR FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTS AND 1 WEEK IN ADVANCE FOR FRESNO TRANSPORTS.

The transporter will wait 15 minutes after your scheduled departure. If you do not arrive on time, your appointment will be canceled and can be rescheduled with Saige Riley only. There are new rules for the transportation services, please call the transporter for a copy of revised rules. Transportation services are for Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Members.

The transporter cannot transport kids to school that have missed the bus. All CVIH appointments are to be scheduled with CVIH transporter. If the CVIH transporter is unable to transport you, they will need to reschedule your appointment. This applies to all medical, dental, nutrition & referral appointments.
