May 29th will be the last day of Head Start for the 2024-2025 school year. Our annual graduation ceremony will be May 29th at 6:00 pm at the BSR POW WOW grounds.

Parents with Head Start children moving on to Foothill next year: Please remember to turn in any registration documents and update immunizations before the end of May this will ensure your child is pre enrolled and ready to begin in August.

### **BSR Environmental Department May 2025**

#### Air Quality during the summer months

There are five big pollutants that affect air quality throughout the U.S. All of these pollutants ground-level ozone, particle pollution, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, and nitrogen dioxide become more prevalent in summer, reaching dangerous levels during hot and sunny weather when winds that would normally mix the atmosphere remain light.

These pollutants, in presences of each other and sunlight, form the smog that can irritate and cause major health problems.

To help Americans prepare for the summer air quality problems, the EPA is once again issuing an air quality forecast for most major cities in the U.S. This forecast will utilize the Air Quality Index (AQI), which is a six-level scale with categories running from good to hazardous.

#### Climate Change- Water

As the climate changes, here at Big Sandy
Rancheria we could face water supply shortages
and impacts to water infrastructure. It takes a
lot of energy to pump, treat, and heat water, so
conserving water reduces greenhouse gas
emissions, too.

Use water efficiently at home at no-to-low cost: Turn off running faucets and run your clothes washer with a full load using cold water.

Check for water leaks in your home: A leaky toilet can waste 200 gallons of water per day.

Consider installing low-flow showerheads: Not only do they save energy and money, you can also take them with you when you move.

Take Shorter Showers: Cutting your shower time by even a minute can help save gallons of water

#### What Could Be Considered Illegal Dumping?

Everyone generates trash that they want to get rid of. How ever, there are some people out there who don't want to pay to throw away their garbage or unwanted items. It is illegal to dump: on a public or private road, or on private property that the public can assess through an easement, or on private property without the owner's consent. Here at Big Sandy we provide weekly trash pick up and access to the community Transfer Station. So be mindful where your dumping your trash.






#### BSR Participating on MMIWGR Vigil Steering Committee-
