Early Head Start (EHS) is continuing to be a huge success and we are so proud of our community in enrolling our young 0-3 aged children to the program. EHS is currently housed in our "old head start" building, as our crew is refurbishing the existing facility, which we are anticipating the facility will be completed by the end of July. We look forward to having a GRAND OPENING to our EHS facility, which all will be welcome to attend.

Our Native Tobacco Distribution department has been very busy. We have increased sales and have added Darrel Telles to our team, as he has had many years of transportation experience and added much-needed shipping components to our business. We would like to thank our employees Halley Smith, Jamie Robertson and Ernie Soto for adapting to change with new additions of Darrell Telles, Darin Loretz and George Edd, to enhance our business.

We have future plans to renovate the old "Sierra Veterinarian Hospital" in Auberry for our future Mono Museum. Our Crew will begin on this museum project, once we have the EHS building and other rehab home projects completed.

Great NEWS! we have been funded for our Missing and Murdered Indigenous People's grant that we applied for in April 2025. We announced this grant at the Fresno State MMIP event and shared that we will be working with our partners, Fresno County Sheriff's Office, Marjoree Mason Center, and the Central Valley Against Human Trafficking among others.

Tribal Member Day at Island Water Park was a huge success, as all that attended had a great time. Thank you, Leann Anguiano, for planning this event!!!

As we look forward to August, we have our Back-to-School event on August 8th 5pm-7pm, which is always well attended. We love seeing our kids getting ready to return to school and further their education, and we wish them much success.

We are please to announce that we have "Summer Youth Work Program" and have our young community members working with our Community Activities and Environmental Departments. # BSR Environmental Department August 2025

## Did you know...

Manufacturing recycled paper uses only 60% of the energy needed to make paper from new materials.

Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a TV for three hours or saves the equivalent of half a gallon of gasoline.

Every ton of paper recycled can save the energy equivalent of 165 gallons of gasoline.

A used aluminum can is recycled and back in use as a new can in as little as 60 days.

A typical glass processing facility can recycle 20 tons of color-sorted glass per hour.

Recycling 1 ton of paper saves 17 mature trees, 7,000 gallons of water, 3 cubic yards of landfill space, and 2 barrels of oil.
