Germ Proof Your Child:

Here are a few tips to keep your family healthy during the cold and covid season. And just a reminder to get your flu shots.

- Hand Washing: hands should be washed for 20 seconds. This should be done before meals, after bathroom breaks, and if your child touches other kids, toys, and pets.
 - 2) Keep wipes & sanitizing gel while on the go.
 - 3) Sneeze and cough into a tissue. Or use the crook of your elbow
- 4) Do not let your child share drinks, utensils, or personal items with anybody. Including you and siblings.

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle! With the holidays approaching

remember the importance of reducing waste. Donate used clothes and toys, reuse packing material and wrapping, and recycle old batteries and broken electronics.

Importance of Native Plants

When selecting native plant materials, it is important to have knowledge of the geographic origin and genetic diversity of the plant source. A good practice is to choose plant sources from an area that matches the restoration site conditions as closely as possible. This helps ensure project success because the stock will be adapted to local climate and soil conditions, and more resistant to damage from freezing, drought, common diseases, and herbivores.

Why Use Native Plant Materials?

Native plant materials are used for a variety of purposes, such as stabilizing stream banks and floodplains, reducing soil erosion and sedimentation, reducing the spread of non-native invasive plants, improving wildlife and fisheries habitat, and mitigating the effects of wildfire and other types of disturbances such as illegal off-road vehicle use.

Work Force Development

The two crews have been busy this past month. They are still working in Yosemite in the Merced Grove area with Calaveras Healthy Impact Solutions (CHIPS). The crew is still working in the Rancheria on the YSRCDC BSR PG&E Powerline project, clearing and cutting brush under the powerlines to reduce potential fire risk. The crew spent six days at Florence Lake working on the Piute Bridge. The crew rode horses fifteen miles into their camp and worksite. They worked on the bridge for four days replacing the runners, handrails, and repairing the bridge abutments.
