BSR Head Start

Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Head Start Program

Dads, grandpas, uncles, and male role models play a crucial role in a child's development. Studies show that children with involved male figures tend to perform better in school, have higher self-esteem, and develop stronger social skills. We encourage all the men in our families to participate in classroom activities, read stories, and attend events.

Your presence makes a difference.

In March our classroom will be full of hands-on learning as we introduce the concept of Simple Machines. Children will explore levers, pulleys, wheels, and more through interactive activities and play. By discovering how these everyday tools make work easier, they will develop problem-solving skills and a deeper understanding of the world around them. Ask your child about their favorite simple machine and how it works. Example of simple machines in our homes include a rolling pin, a door knob, and fishing rod.

Please remember to send your child with a warm jacket, gloves, and hat. We want all our little ones to stay cozy and warm during outdoor play.

Quality time

1. Play with your children. Let them choose the activity, and don't worry about rules. Just go with the flow and have fun. 2. Read every night: Cuddling up with your child and a book is a great bonding experience that will set them up for a lifetime of reading. 3. Make and eat meals with your children whenever possible. If time is limited, look for simple meals that require very little preparation, or grab a healthy snack such as an apple and sit for a few minutes and chat with your child.

Big Sandy Transfer Station is only accepting bagged household trash. DO NOT leave or throw large item in the trash bins. DO NOT leave items outside the transfer station. Mattress Recycling Program

BSR is now offering a pilot program to eliminate the illegal dumping of mattresses throughout the Rancheria. Environmental staff are offering a one day a month curbside collection of mattresses. March 26th, 2025 will be the first collection day. (date subject to change). Please do not bring mattresses to the BSR transfer station!

Illegal mattress disposal poses significant environmental concerns as discarded mattresses often end up in landfills where they take up large amounts of space, release harmful chemicals like flame retardants into the soil and groundwater, and contribute to methane emissions due to their slow decomposition process, ultimately polluting the environment and impacting ecosystems. What is an Aquifer?

About 30 percent of California's total annual water supply comes from groundwater in normal years, and up to 60 percent in drought years. Local community's usage may be different; many areas rely exclusively on groundwater while others use only surface water supplies. Contrary to popular opinion, groundwater does not exist in underground lakes. Groundwater fills pores (spaces) between sand, gravel, silt and clay in water-bearing formations known as aquifers.

Abandoned Vehicles

Abandoned vehicles are hazardous to the environment and public health. They can pollute the soil and water create a breeding ground for pests, and take up valuable space.

Environmental Impact:

- Leaks: Fluids like oil, gasoline, and antifreeze can leak into the soil and water.
- Pests: Abandoned vehicles can attract rats and mice, which can spread disease.
- Space: Abandoned vehicles take up space that could be used for other purpose.
- Arson and Vandalism: Abandoned vehicles can be targets for arson and vandalism, which cause air pollution.

There were basic disaster response skills that were taught including Fire Safety, disasters medical operation, team organization, terrorism response, support in emergency operations centers, help manage traffic and crowd control, provide basic medical aid, search and rescue victims safely and so much more.

Your appointment must be made and verified with the cap department *before* your spot CAN BE RESERVED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. SCHEDULE APPOINTMENTS ONLY WITH Brandi Kelley 24 hours prior for local transports and 1 week in advance for Fresno TRANSPORTS.

The transporter will wait 15 minutes after your scheduled departure. If you do not arrive on time, your appointment will be canceled and can be rescheduled with Brandi Kelley only. There are new rules for the transportation services, please call the transporter for a copy of revised rules. Transportation services are for Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Members.

The transporter cannot transport kids to school that have missed the bus. All CVIH appointments are to be scheduled with CVIH transporter. If the CVIH transporter is unable to transport you, they will need to reschedule your appointment. This applies to all medical, dental, nutrition & referral appointments.
