Did you know Ground Water

Pollution Includes:

- Motor oil
- Cooking Grease
- Chemicals like fertilizers, insecticides, detergents used to wash your car
- Animal Waste
- Septic Tanks
- Waste Water

Our ground water on Big Sandy absorbed any and all pollutants and may contaminate our drinking water without proper filtration station. Keep in mind whenever you come in contact with any of these pollutants. Make sure to properly recycle to ensure the highest quality ground water.

Climate Change Threatens

traditional ways of life

Chronic stresses such as extreme poverty are being exacerbated by climate change impacts: these impacts include reduced access to traditional foods, decreased water quality, and increasing exposure to health and safety hazards.

Climate change impacts Tribal Lands and Some plants used for medicines and food are becoming increasingly, difficult to find, or are no longer found in historical ranges. With the recent Creek fire in our area, it has made gathering very difficult for basket weaving and traditional medicine.

Composting

How your compost efforts going? It's as simple as finding any container with a lid.

1. Start your compost pile in the container
2. Lay twigs or straw first, a few inches deep
3. Add compost materials in layers, alternating moist and dry
4. Add manure, green manure (clover, buckwheat, wheat grass, grass clippings)
5. Keep compost moist and keep turning it

BSR Head Start

Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Head Start Program Annual Report

The primary objective of the Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Head Start Program is to offer age-appropriate guidance to Head Start children and their families in crucial areas such as education, nutrition, mental health, and social services. Operating from September to May, the program runs for 150 days. At present, BSR Head Start serves 20 children and their families, delivering its comprehensive services in a center-based setting every Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 5:30 pm.

2. Medical and Dental Screenings

66% Of Head Start students had up to date physicals

20% Of Head Start students updated physicals with in the school year

73% Of students had dental screenings or follow up dental care during the school year

3. Average Monthly attendance (COVID-19)

Did not focus on physical attendance this year because of COVID 19

4. During the 2022/2023 school year, our program experienced a relaxation of covid-19 protocols and a decline in cases. However, as covid-19 cases decreased, we observed a resurgence of various childhood illnesses, including flu, colds, stomach flu, hand-foot-and-mouth disease, and pink eye, among others. Despite ongoing construction on our new building, we continued to operate from our temporary classrooms. Due to space limitations, we had to reduce our student enrollment from 20 to 15 students. Despite these challenges, we persevered, and the school year proceeded smoothly. It was truly gratifying to witness our students flourishing in their learning and development. This school year we have 12 students moving onto the local elementary school, this is the most we've had moved on in the past 3 years. California is moving towards universal preschool in the upcoming years and we may see a reduction in our enrollment as a result.

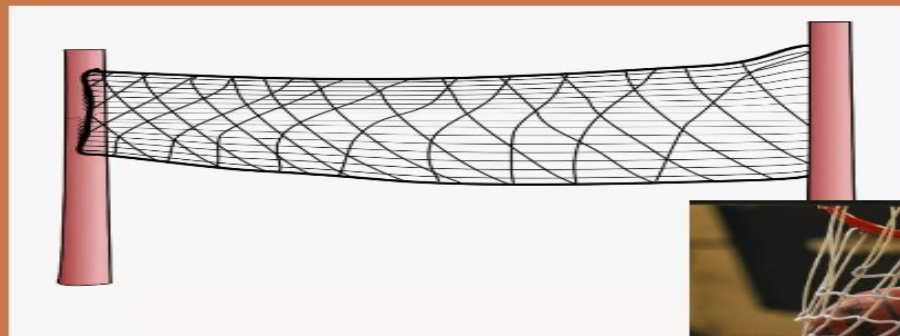

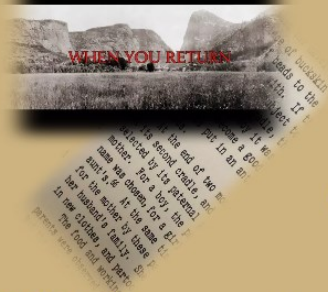

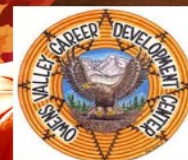
